Destination Hoover International (DHI) is dedicated to promoting cultural exchange both at home and abroad. One of DHI's primary missions is to facilitate successful international relationships as a positive influence in Hoover among our youth, adults, businesses and organizations.

The scholarship winner from each high school (Spain Park and Hoover High) will receive a \$2,000 scholarship. The award will be given to a Hoover City Schools senior who meets the following criteria:

- City of Hoover resident
- Cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher
- Demonstrates interest in a field that promotes cultural exchange (International Business, Foreign Language, etc.) through a 700 - 1,000 word essay (see prompt below)
- Pursuing a bachelor's degree sought from an accredited university

Students should download, print and fill out the attached scholarship application and submit it with the following:

- 700 - 1,000 word essay on the importance of cultural exchange and how your degree will prepare you to promote cultural exchange
- AND**
- 3 letters of recommendation that highlight applicant's leadership potential
 - letters must be professional references from a teacher, school official, club sponsor, employer, etc.
 - ***letters from relatives or family are prohibited***
 - Official High School Transcript
 - Resume (optional but preferred)

Applications will be judged by the DHI Scholarship Committee based on three criteria:

- Academic Merit based on a combination of courses and GPA
- Leadership Potential as listed in community and school involvement
- Interest in Cultural Exchange through community involvement, letters of recommendation and personal essay

Applications will be reviewed by the DHI Scholarship Committee, comprised of 2 DHI active board members and one non-board member. The DHI Scholarship Committee reserves the right to ask for additional information from applicants. In addition, interviews may be held at the discretion of the committee. ***Relatives of DHI, City Council members, state and local elected officials or City of Hoover employees are not eligible for consideration.***
